

DRASCOMBE RACING HANDICAPS - PORTSMOUTH YARDSTICKS

Traditionally racing is not part of the “Drascombe ethos” but there are a few exceptions.

There does not appear to be an RYA “official” Portsmouth Yardstick for Drascombes but both the Kilchoan club (Ardnamurchan) and West Wittering club (Chichester harbour) have raced them against other boats and developed the following. These tend to average out fairly well over a long period in reasonably sheltered waters though different weather conditions favour different types. However the ability of the helm and crew will generally have a bigger effect than the handicap!

$$\text{Corrected Time (C)} = \text{Elapsed Time (E)} / \text{Portsmouth Yardstick (PY)} \times 1,000$$
